These performances provide a less formal, more supportive atmosphere in order to reduce anxiety levels.

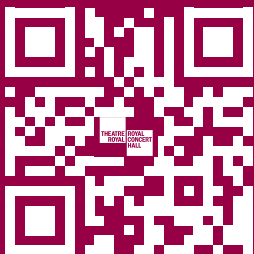

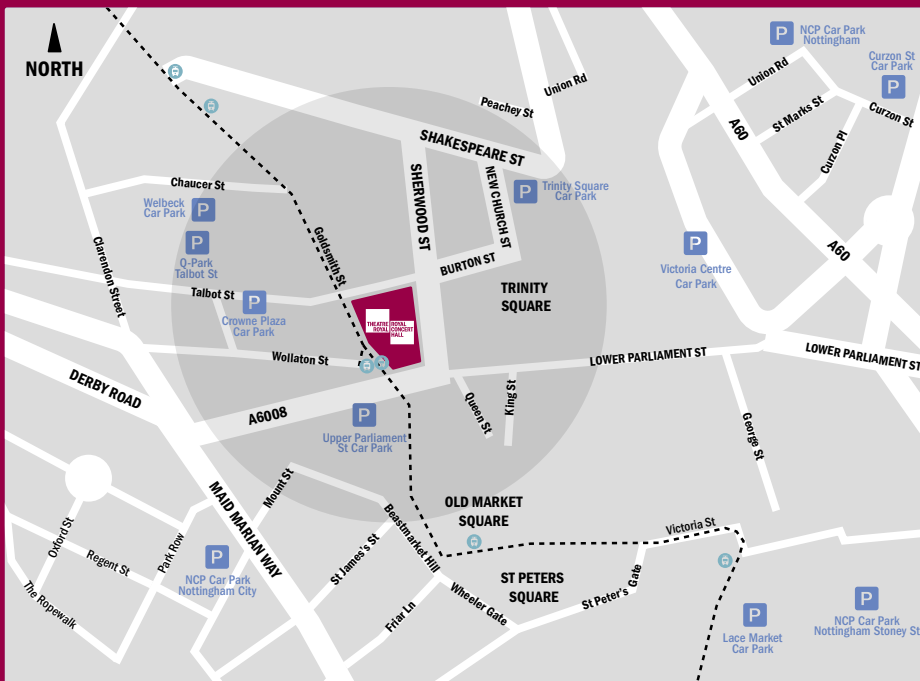
