- Hearing enhancement systems within both auditoria for hearing aid users – there are two systems to choose from: an infra-red Sennheiser transmission system (which operates using your hearing aid and a venue neck loop) or Mobile Connect (a WiFi-enabled system which works in conjunction with an app on your smartphone)
- Lowered sections at bars, merchandise and food outlets
- An assistance dog sitting service offered to customers who do not wish to take their dog inside the auditorium. Staff are also trained to be Sighted Guides for customers requiring guiding assistance
- Visual stories to help customers with access needs to familiarise themselves with the venue before a visit
- A range of Sign Language interpreted, Captioned, Audio-described and Relaxed performances
- Stoma-friendly facilities – all our accessible toilets are equipped with hooks on doors, shelf space, mirrors and disposal bins

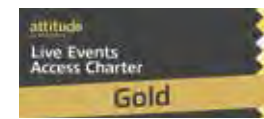

A BSL interpreted performance is where the vocal line is interpreted into sign language. The interpreter stands at the front of the stage to one side allowing you to view both the signer and the production.



AUDIO DESCRIBED

Live commentary via personalised headphones for blind and partially sighted people. Braille and Large Print cast lists will be available for these performances, with programme notes broadcast 15 minutes prior to the performance.



TOUCH TOURS

Touch tours enable blind and partially sighted people a unique opportunity to go onto the stage and explore the sets, costumes and props before the performance begins.



CAPTIONED

English text displayed on a unit for people who are hard of hearing. Captions also include sound effects, offstage noises and character names.



RELAXED PERFORMANCES

Relaxed performances provide an opportunity for customers who may find it difficult to come and see a show to experience the joy of live theatre. It's still the same show but with some small changes to sound levels, lighting and no strobe lighting is used. These performances provide a less formal, more supportive atmosphere in order to reduce anxiety levels.

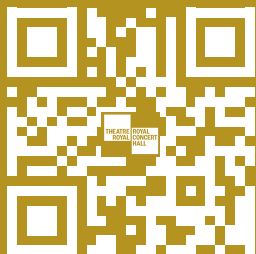

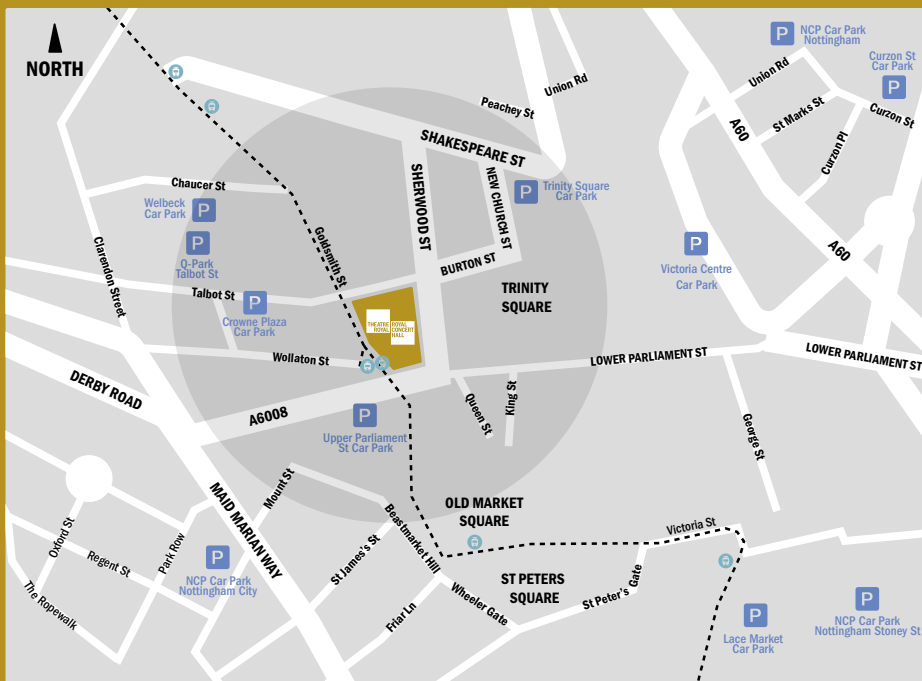
